HOLIDAY ATTRACTIONS

STANLEY PARK, BRIGHT NIGHTS

In December, Stanley Park's Bright Nights event takes place, where you can hop on board the train to take you around the park to see giant gingerbread houses and light displays.

VANDUSEN BOTANICAL GARDENS, FESTIVAL OF LIGHTS
